



Westchester Academy

Westchester Academy is a small private school engaged in preparing students for college. It takes gifted high school students, and focuses on a business/technology curriculum, with the intention of giving students the best, most vigorous education available.

There are also 7 students per class which are considered Independent Study. Their classes are partially taken online and through private tutoring. These students are secretly active as super powered agents of the school. They attend in class when possible, but as all classes are recorded, they are expected to catch up from times when they are on missions.

There are 60 Student Dorm rooms

Students (other than Independent Study) are housed here, double occupancy
The 96 students use 48 of the rooms. 8 rooms are used (single occupancy) by R.A.s (Resident Assistants). This leaves 4 spare rooms for guests, etc. Two of the RA's are considered "Senior" Advisors. Senior Advisors are graduates of the school and serve directly under the Headmaster/Headmistress.

Staff Housing : The first floor of the Main building has Staff Housing for 12 people. Full Time Teachers use 6 of these, Admin use 3, and the Nurse 1, leaving 2 spare rooms.

Additional Staff Housing is located above the Auxiliary Building : 12 rooms.

Resident Assistants and Senior Advisors (Senior RA's) are former students who commute by train or car to a nearby college. They are paid and receive free housing.

The Westchester Academy is in Westchester County, NY - about an hour from NYC. A train passes nearby every two hours on weekdays, a brisk walk or short drive from the school by shuttle. It is between Harrison and Port Chester (Salem Center in the MCU).


Main Building Dorms

Auxiliary Building


First Floor is the Motor Pool & Auto Shop




Independent Studies (IS) Building


IS Students have special training classes Monday, Wednesday, and Friday after normal classes end.
