Stomp: Devil Dinosaur's stomp attack can take one of two forms:


- A one-footed stomp can reach into an adjacent area and inflict MN damage
- A leaping stomp reaches up to two areas away for UN damage. Those attempting to dodge a leaping stomp do so at -1CS. Devil can also perform a ground strike maneuver using this ability.

Leaping: Devil moves at RM ground speed and can leap up to three areas, but not higher than one area.

Body Armor: AM body armor, IN against energy attacks

ROLEPLAYING NOTES

Devil Dinosaur has above-average intelligence for a dinosaur, on par with a human's. He has a strong sense of justice, and the instinctive savagery of a carnivore. He will preemptively attack those he perceives as his enemies, and is extremely protective of his companions.

HISTORY

Devil is a dinosaur from "Dinosaur World" in Earth-78411, an alternate reality in the past, in which dinosaurs co-exist with primitive hominids. There has been some discrepancy in various sources about Devil's species, but it is

most commonly believed that he is a mutant specimen of the Devil Beasts, a species that is an evolutionary offshoot of Tyrannosaurus Rex.

The young Devil Dinosaur was nearly burned to death by a tribe of Killer-Folk, hostile beings native to his planet, but was rescued by Moon-Boy, a young member of a rival tribe, the Small-Folk. Exposure to the Killer-folk's fire activated a mutation in the dinosaur which gave him powers greater than others of his species and turned his skin from olive green to flame red. Devil Dinosaur was fiercely loyal to his constant companion, Moon-Boy, and seemed more intelligent than the average dinosaur.

The pair had several adventures on Dinosaur World, including avenging the death of Devil's family by the Killer-Folk, stopping an alien invasion that would have wiped out all of Moon-Boy's people, and destroying the Prime Computer, which had imprisoned a trio of New Folk in a mini-paradise and away from harm; however, it failed at this and was destroyed when Devil freed them. This time also included his first visit to Earth-616 when he fell into a portal and he ended up in Zuma City, Nevada. The locals began attacking him, but he was returned to Dinosaur World. Devil's adventures around this time also included fighting, and teaming up with, both the Hulk and Godzilla on separate occasions when they were transported to Dinosaur World.

For a time, Devil and Moon-Boy joined the Fallen Angels when the group was transported to Dinosaur World, returning with them to Earth-616. After the Fallen Angels disbanded, Moon Boy and Devil Dinosaur returned to the Savage Land, but appeared on Earth-616 sporadically, encountering the likes of Slapstick, Excalibur, Howard the Duck, and Ghost Rider. Stranded in modern day Earth-616 after their teleportation there by Jennifer Kale, Devil Dinosaur and Moon-Boy were hypnotized into joining the Circus of Crime. They were rescued by Spider-Man, who returned them to Dinosaur World.

The Heroes for Hire mercenaries went on a mission for S.H.I.E.L.D. to retrieve Moon-Boy from the Savage Land and encountered Devil Dinosaur in the process. Devil was found fiercely guarding a nest containing a clutch of eggs that apparently he himself had laid and the dinosaur abandoned

Moon-Boy to ensure their safety. The discrepancy between this development and his previously presumed male sex was noted by the mercenaries, who could only speculate as to the cause of the change.

Devil and Moon-Boy remained in Dinosaur World until Moon-Boy died in an attempt to reclaim the sacred Night Stone, in actuality a Kree Omni-Wave Projector, from the Killer Folk. As the Killer Folk were sucked into a vortex, Devil was once again transported to Earth-616. Determined to avenge the fallen Moon-Boy, Devil sought out the Nightstone, which had fallen into the hands of Lunella Lafayette. Lunella teamed with Devil Dinosaur, and the pair formed a bond through Lunella's newfound Inhuman power to switch consciousness with Devil. Aside from some brief intervals, Moon Girl and Devil Dinosaur have since remained a team, with Lunella harboring Devil Dinosaur in her secret laboratory beneath P.S. 20.

ROLEPLAYING NOTES

Mel-Varr, being a child, has the emotional maturity of a typical Earth ten-year-old. Mel-Varr tries hard to live up to the expectations of his father, and fears coming up short. Hailing from a warrior culture, Mel-Varr will go to great lengths to prove himself worthy. He has a crush on Lunella, which he typically conceals with bravado.

HISTORY

Mel-Varr is a young Kree from Nova Hala IV whose father, General Pad-Varr, ridiculed him for spending so



much time at the computer daydreaming about fighting Inhumans after failing to be accepted to the Kree Academy to continue the thousand-generation House of Varr family tradition of serving as warriors of the Kree Empire.

To prove himself worthy, Mel-Varr used an analytical system of various metrics to sort for potentially weak Inhuman targets, seeking to gain favor with the Empire by capturing one in a purely symbolic victory. The computer suggested the newly transformed Moon Girl to be the lowest threat level, so Mel-Varr assumed the identity of Captain Kree, in honor of Mar-Vell, and traveled to Earth where he posed as Marvin Ellis, a new transfer student to Public School 20 Anna Silver who had allegedly just moved to New York from Kalamazoo, Michigan.

He attempted to befriend Lunella to get closer to his target; however, she had not yet learned to control her newly manifested powers, and fled the school until she and Devil Dinosaur could find a way to swap back into their proper bodies.

The next day Marvin, Lunella, and fellow students Eduardo and Zoe were put in the same group for a science project, but didn't get along. That night Captain Kree responded to Lenny and his partner robbing a store called Candy Party on the Lower East Side and then jammed NYPD bands to prevent them from responding before Moon Girl did. He attempted to arrest her for deserting the Kree Empire and betraying them with her cowardice; however, Mel-Varr was no match for Moon Girl and Devil Dinosaur who dispatched him after a brief skirmish. After another tense day at school, the pair faced off yet again, but this time Captain Kree damaged the Q train tracks over the Manhattan Bridge, endangering civilians, and drawing the attention of Ms. Marvel.

Following Ms. Marvel's mediation of their conflict, Moon Girl and Kid Kree established a begrudging truce, with Kid Kree even assisting Lunella in the defeat of an army of Doombots. Mel-Varr in fact has developed a crush on Lunella, but in typical young boy fashion, his antagonism hides his growing affection. Lunella is far from thrilled by his confession of love. Mel-Varr has renounced his vendetta against Lunella, and remains at large in New York City.

KILLER-FOLK GANG

GROUP HISTORY

The Killer-Folk are an aggressive tribe of New Folk, native to the Valley of the Flame on Dinosaur World in Earth-78411.

A Killer-Folk chieftain named Thorn-Teeth came into possession of an Omni-Wave Projector they called the Nightstone; however, their longtime rival the Small-Folk named Moon-Boy, and his partner Devil Dinosaur, frightened Thorn-Teeth and Gurf off, and then seized the artifact, but consequently Thok, Rachacha, and Tharg beat Moon-Boy to death.

When Coach Hrbek accidentally activated Lunella Lafayette's Omni-Wave Projector in another reality, it opened a portal across space and time to Earth-616, allowing the Killer-Folk to cross over into present day New York City. The Mutant Devil Beast followed, looking to avenge the death of his longtime companion at the hands of the Killer-Folk.

While in New York, the Killer-Folk took control of the territory run by the Yancy Street Gang. Taking a liking to Earth-616, the gang has disguised themselves as New Yorkers. The Killer-Folk Gang currently rules Yancy Street, although they are apparently no longer enemies of Moon Girl and Devil Dinosaur.

KNOWN POWERS

Super Intellect: Lunella's high Reason score is the result of her extreme intellect. Amadeus Cho declared her to be the "smartest person in the whole world", an assertion verified by both Dr. Bruce Banner, and the staff of Rockefeller University.

Enhanced Strength: Kid Kree noted that Lunella's Inhuman DNA provides her with a degree of enhanced strength. However, as Moon Girl is only a 10-year-old child, her strength level remains well within human norms. It is possible that this aspect of her genetic makeup will further manifest as she matures.

Consciousness Transference: As a result of her Terrigenesis, Lunella has the ability to switch her consciousness with Devil Dinosaur's, effectively putting her in control of Devil Dinosaur's body, and vice versa. Initially, the transference was involuntary, but Lunella has gained more control over her ability with time. The transference

is triggered whenever Lunella is angry, hungry, or experiences other strong emotions. To avoid an involuntary mind-switch at these times, Moon Girl must make a Yellow FEAT roll at Excellent ability; likewise, she must make a Yellow FEAT roll to voluntarily trigger the transference at any other time.

Lunella retains her own intelligence while in Devil Dinosaur's body, but her speech capability is limited due to Devil's lack of human vocal cords. Conversely, when Lunella's body is controlled by Devil Dinosaur, she

behaves in a feral manner, snapping, biting, and growling.

Moon Girl at one time believed her power to be triggered by the full moon. However, this may not be the case, as it has not been addressed since, and Moon Girl has increasingly gained control over her ability.

Devil Dinosaur possesses the same physical weakness as Lunella when he is controlling Moon Girl's body.

Lunella likewise has all of Devil Dinosaur's powers when she is controlling his body.

EQUIPMENT

Invention is Lunella's forte, as she is able to use her keen intellect to craft just about anything she needs. However, due to her limited resources, her devices tend to be constructed from everyday objects such as traffic cones, soda bottles, LEGOs, etc., often giving them a bizarre and humorous appearance. Some of Moon Girl's more notable kit-bashed inventions include her Fan Cannon, Moon Mobile interplanetary craft, a retro-engineered version of Cerebro, and the Dino-Byte Prototype, a triceratops mecha to house her body when it was controlled by Devil Dinosaur's consciousness.

Battle suit: Moon Girl's typical gear includes her "battle suit" consisting of boxing gear and various homemade devices to help her fight crime. She will often augment the suit with additional equipment of her own devising. The battle suit's capabilities include the following:

- *Body armor* – Poor (4)
- *Boxing gloves* – Moon Girl's gloves are of Excellent material, allowing her to inflict 16 points as a Blunt attack. The gloves are spring-loaded to allow attacks up to one area away.
- *Boots* – Moon Girl's suit includes retractable roller skates that allow Typical movement (3 areas/round) on any flat, relatively smooth surface. Her boots are also fitted with springs that allow her to leap upwards with Excellent ability (20' maximum, or 1 area/round).
- *Gyro-copter* – Lunella's backpack is fitted with retractable rotor blades and a high-efficiency battery, allowing flight at Good (4 areas/round) speed for up to one hour.

- *Goggles* – offering Good (10) protection against blindness attacks such as bright light, tear gas, etc.

Secret Laboratory: Moon Girl's Secret Laboratory is located within the substructure of Public School 20 Anna Silver on the Lower East Side of Manhattan in New York City. It can be accessed via a ventilation duct in the girls' restroom or through the sewer system, including a manhole in front of the school on Essex Street and an egress at East River Park.

This is where Lunella crafts her inventions (mostly from found items) and has set up a living space for Devil Dinosaur. In game terms, it is considered a Small headquarters of Good material, and contains scaled-down versions of the Computer Room, Workshop, and Laboratory packages.

Avengers communicator: Given to her by Ms. Marvel. It is unknown whether using it will call all of the Avengers, or just Kamala.

Despite Lunella's superhuman intellect, she still has the emotional maturity of a 10-year-old girl. She often expresses frustration at being misunderstood by children her own age, and will empathize with anyone she perceives

to be an outsider. She is especially drawn to those who show high intelligence and like to dream big. She can be headstrong and stubborn, and has a passion for exploring the unknown.

HISTORY

Lunella Lafayette is a brilliant young girl living on the Lower East Side of Manhattan. Her fellow students at Public School 20 Anna Silver frequently mocked her and called her names like "Moon Girl," because her superior intellect often caused her to daydream and invent strange gadgets. Through her studies, Lunella became obsessed with the Kree. Lunella built a device designed to uncover Kree technology, which she used to find an Omni-Wave Projector hidden beneath the Brooklyn Bridge.

Elsewhere, long ago in Earth-78411 (Dinosaur World), a New Folk tribesman was also revealed to be in possession of an Omni-Wave Projector they called the Nightstone. When one of Lunella's teachers accidentally activated her device, it opened a portal across space and time from Dinosaur World to Earth-616, allowing the primitive Killer Folk to cross over into present day New York City. Devil Dinosaur followed, looking to avenge the apparent death of his longtime companion Moon-Boy at their hands. Going through the portal, Devil Dinosaur ended up in New York City.

Lunella had identified the Inhuman gene within her own DNA and feared being transformed into a monster due to the changes brought about by Terrigen Mist. Following the Inhumans' detonation of a Terrigen bomb, she took drastic action to try to find a way to remove the Inhuman DNA by using the Nightstone. With Lunella refusing to give up the Nightstone, Devil Dinosaur was forced to bring her on his rampage through the city as he searched for the Killer Folk.

Lunella harbored Devil Dinosaur in a laboratory that she had built in the depths of her school, growing increasingly frustrated that she was stuck with the "big red dummy," but finding him useful when he helped save the lives of her teacher and class during a fire. However, the Hulk (Amadeus Cho) arrived, seeking to

apprehend Devil Dinosaur for his earlier rampage and accused him of the fire. Lunella refused, declaring that she needed Devil Dinosaur. Growing frustrated with Amadeus patronizing her and undermining her intelligence, Lunella used a few homemade weapons to fight Cho, but only succeeded in accidentally knocking out Devil Dinosaur.

Feeling responsible for Devil Dinosaur's arrest, Lunella broke him out under the moniker of Moon Girl. After the Killer Folk failed to kidnap Lunella from school to be a blood sacrifice to the Nightstone, Lunella decided to confront them. Reclaiming the Nightstone, Lunella hoped that she could use it to prevent her transformation into an Inhuman, but at that precise moment she was caught in

a Terrigen cloud. Devil Dinosaur took Lunella's cocoon to her lab and guarded it until she hatched. Lunella was relieved she had not changed physically, but was dismayed to learn her Inhuman power caused her consciousness and that of Devil Dinosaur's to switch.


Devil Dinosaur and Moon Girl's next opponent came in the form of Kid Kree - a misunderstood Kree boy who had failed to enter the academy twice, who sought to capture an Inhuman to impress his father and make a name for himself on Earth as Captain Marvel had - who disguised himself as a new student in Lunella's class, Marvin Ellis. Moon Girl and Devil Dinosaur fought Kid Kree several times, once being separated by Ms. Marvel, who recognized their fight as the childish

squabble it was, but still entrusted Moon Girl with a device to contact her if things ever got out of hand.

After confrontations with Doctor Doom, and Illa, the "daughter" of Ego the Living Planet, Moon Girl and Devil Dinosaur found themselves in outer space in a rocket ship of Lunella's design. On the way back to Earth, Lunella decides that Devil Dinosaur truly belongs in the Savage Land, and tearfully used the Omni-Wave Projector to tearfully return him to Moon Boy. Upon her return to New York, Lunella discarded the Projector. Realizing that she still needed help, she began to contact other superheroes in the search for a potential partner. Lunella and Devil Dinosaur were reunited during the Monsters Unleashed storyline, when Kei Kawade, a. k. a. Kid Kaiju, used his powers to summon Devil Dinosaur, having the effect of summoning Moon Girl as well. When Leviathan Servitors attacked the Baxter Building, Kei, Moon Girl, Devil Dinosaur and other heroes fought the Leviathans and other monsters, ultimately defeating the Leviathan Queen.

Devil Dinosaur and Moon Girl soon joined up with Daisy Johnson's Secret Warriors. After rescuing Karnak from a prison camp and encountering the Howling Commandos, the team was found by the X-Men. The team confronted Dark Beast and Mister Hyde, along with Hydra's Avengers. After a brief fight, the team was captured. While trying to break Devil out of his cage, Moon Girl was knocked unconscious by Leer, a fellow Inhuman. Fortunately, Moon Girl and Devil switched brains just in time, enabling Moon Girl to lead the Warriors to an Inhuman prison camp. There, the Warriors planned a jailbreak with the imprisoned Inhumans, when the Underground resistance arrived to help them. It was later revealed that Leer was Karnak's son and that Karnak had sold him to Mr. Sinister to help activate his powers.
