KNOWN POWERS:

Modified Skeletal Structure: Rick Rojatt has had 60% of his skeletal structure replaced with steel. As a result, the Human Fly receives a +1CS bonus to any damage inflicted by an attack in which he utilizes his entire body as a weapon up to RM(30) damage.

Iron Will: Due to his physical condition and his mental conditioning, he has EX(20) Iron Will, enabling him to suffer through pain without allowing it to affect him.

EQUIPMENT:

The Human Fly has used a variety of enhanced devices and vehicles designed by his colleague Ted Locke, such as the following:

Baton: The Baton carried by the Human Fly is composed of RM(30) materials and has several abilities available to it which are activated by pressing the studs along the side of the baton itself.

 Bolo: The Bolo cap is a single use item and fires a steel cable of RM(30) strength that can constrict an enemy or allow The Human Fly to swing up to 3 areas away.



- Light: The Baton is capable of emitting an EX(20) intensity beam of light for 6 areas.
- Spike: The spike is composed of RM(30) material strength and can be used to inflict up to EX(20) edged attack damage or as a tool.
- Gas Burst: The baton can unleash a burst of gas that has a RM(30) potency, causing the target to roll an Endurance FEAT or fall unconscious for 1-10 rounds.
- Electric Discharge: The Baton can unleash an electric shock of RM(30) intensity.

Magnetic Boots and Gloves: These provide The Human Fly with a EX(20) ability to scale and cling to metal surfaces. The boots have jets built into

them and can be used to make RM(30) leaps.

Steel Mesh Cape: The mesh cape is flexible and has a EX(20) material strength. Often, The Human Fly can use it as a net to catch objects. The cape is sometimes treated with chemicals such as a EX(20) Flame Retardant.

Air Tanks: The Human Fly also carries and uses air tanks to protect himself in oxygen deprived environs.

Suction Cups: The Human Fly has suction cups available to him that enable him to wall crawl on smooth surfaces (i.e., glass) with Good ability.

Cable Gun: The cable gun can fire a piton up to 3 areas away allowing The





Human Fly to cover ground by swinging 3 areas or providing a grapple to descend or break a fall.

TALENTS: Acrobatics, Martial Arts A, C, E, Multi-Lingual (Sign Language), Musician-Guitar, Weapon Specialist: Baton, Pilot-Driving, Motorcyclist and Skies.

CONTACTS: Margarita Mercado, Ted Locke. He can likely call on Spider-Man, White Tiger, Daredevil, or any of the popular 1970s heroes.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

ROLEPLAYING NOTES:

The Human Fly is an outstanding stuntman, acrobat and athlete at peak performance and strength. He is a very good hand to hand combatant due to his trained reflexes.

HISTORY:

Rick Rojatt's car was run off the road in North Carolina, U.S.A. His wife and children were killed instantly, but he survived in critical condition. Rick struggled against his bandaged form and remained defiant against the doctor's diagnosis that he would remain a cripple for the remainder of his life. During his ordeal in the hospital over 60% of Rick's skeletal structure was replace with steel. Privately exercising from the confines of his hospital bed it would take months before he could stand.

Several years later, he had trained so that he could perform minor acrobatic feats and lift objects again. Rick moved around the hospital at night and spoke to the other crippled patients trying to inspire hope so that they would not give up on life. Two of these individuals would be Ted Locke and Blaze Kendall. During this time, Rick came up with the idea to become a

stuntman in a colorful outfit that would raise money for charity. Also during his stay in the hospital Rick learned sign language.

After leaving the hospital Rick asked the nearly forgotten stunt man Malik to train him in all of his skills. After completing his training Rojatt assembled a team to assist him; this team included innovative technician Ted Locke and skilled pilot Blaze Kendall.

The Human Fly went on to have many adventures, rescuing people (typically disabled children) and defeating nefarious plots. Almost all of his adventures had some connection to his various stunts he would be performing, such as riding a motorcycle across a high-wire, tight-rope walking between two skyscrapers, or jet skiing (with rocket assist) over Niagara Falls!

HUMAN FLY'S CREW AND EQUIPMENT

VEHICLES

The Human Fly had many vehicles specially equipped for his stunts. With enough preparation, the Human Fly and his team can prepare practically any device or vehicle!



Rocket Powered Motorbike: The Human Fly has several modified motorbikes with the following statistics:

Control Speed BodyGD RM GD

The Human Fly is skilled enough that he can race the bike along a tight wire.

Rocket Powered Snowmobile: The Human Fly is ready for any environment often trading in his trusty bike for a snowmobile with a rocket powered exhaust. This vehicle has the following stats:

Control Speed BodyGD EX GD



Jet Powered Skate Board: The Human Fly is a master skate boarder. He often uses this device in his shows and to get around urban environments. The skate board has the following stats:

Control Speed Body EX EX GD

The Body of the skate board shares no type of body armor but is instead given as a means to determine material strength.

Bus: The Human Fly and his crew travel across the world in a small bus. The bus has the following abilities:

Control Speed Body Protection

Helicopter: The Human Fly and his crew also travel by helicopter and often use it in their stunts and shows. This craft has the following abilities:

Control Speed Body Protection EX EX GD FE

Plane: The Human Fly and his crew also own a small craft air plane that possesses VTOL capabilities making it much simpler for The Human Fly to travel the world. This craft has the following statistics:

Powers:

Metal Hands: Ted's hands were replaced with steel hooks (AM material strength) that do not provide him with very good manual dexterity (-1CS to fine motor skills). However, they do cause Good Edged damage.
