





GAMMA CORPS

GROUP HISTORY

Gamma Corps is a roque superhuman military unit organized by General John Ryker and comprised of gammamutated humans who seek revenge upon the similarly mutated manmonster Hulk (Bruce Banner), blaming him for various tragedies in their lives. Shortly after the Hulk first appeared, General "Thunderbolt" Ross held a meeting, which General Rvker attended. Having just learned that his wife Lucy had been diagnosed with cancer, Ryker was interested in capturing and studying the Hulk to see if his fast-healing physiology could cure diseases. Using blood collected from the Hulk's first encounter with Wolverine, Lucy's cancer was wiped out, but the gamma residue in her system caused it to return a hundredfold later, mutating her. After initially trying defeat a Hulk angrier than at any to destroy Bruce Banner's life, including sending the gamma-irradiated Flux (Benny Tibbetts) against him, General Ryker was forced into hiding while the elite intelligence agency S.H.I.E.L.D. hunted him.

During this time, Ryker located and recruited individuals who blamed the Hulk for tragedies in their own lives. He offered each the chance for revenge if they accepted being transformed into gamma-mutated beings themselves. They included: Brian Talbot, younger brother of Major Glenn Talbot, who died battling the Hulk; Nichole Martin, a Floridian housewife whose Young son was killed when a truck thrown into the air during a battle between the Hulk and the Abomination crashed into their car; Gideon Wilson, father of the Hulk's late sidekick Jim Wilson, who had died from AIDS-related complications: Timmy Wilkerson, who remained in a vegetative state since birth after suffering a stroke in the womb shortly after his parents encountered the Hulk; finally Eliot Franklin, professional criminal and one time member of the Circus of Crime known as the Clown, who had been defeated repeatedly by the Hulk.

Each received DNA treatments taken from various gamma-irradiated beings. Talbot became Grey, a Hulk-like being with the Leader's intellect. Martin, who lost two of her limbs and other body parts in her accident, received Abomination DNA. This caused her missing and injured body parts to regrow but in the likeness of the Abomination. She was given the



codename Mess. Wilson, infused with DNA from Doc Samson, became Mr. Gideon and found his powers were opposite from Samson's, in that he could not grow his hair out and still retain his strength. Wilkerson was artificially aged several years to a young teen and received Leader DNA as well, bringing him out of his comalike state and granting him intelligence as Prodigy. The insane Franklin was turned into the monstrous Griffin using DNA samples collected from the Harpy

(Betty Ross). Of the five, only Grey and Griffin appear capable of reverting back to their human forms.

Loyal to Ryker, the new Gamma Corps trained in preparation to combat the Hulk. However, the Hulk was exiled to an alien world by Tony Stark and the other members of the "Illuminati" in a bid to grant their old friend peace away from mankind. With his ultimate target now gone, Ryker redirected his focus and utilized the Corps to pursue his other agendas. They were sent to

South America to infiltrate a Hydra base where Ryker's previous gamma experiment, Flux, was being held prisoner. The Corps killed the AIM (Advanced Idea Mechanics) agents holding Flux, including some using black market Crimson Dynamo armor. they located Flux, Once assassinated him on Ryker's order. In the midst of this operation, Ryker learned that the Hulk had returned to Earth, leading the Warbound, an army of survivors from the planet Sakaar. The Hulk made his presence known in New York, demanding vengeance against Stark and the "Illuminati" for exiling him and causing the destruction of Sakaar. Ryker saw this as an opportunity to strike, and sent the team to confront the Hulk.

The Gamma Corps were later attacked by a haywire Hulk A.I., who wanted to kill them as part of the plan of the original Hulk to neutralize every Gamma-powered mutate from the Earth, even though the original Hulk's plan didn't include lethal force. After following the haywire A.I. to Fort Knox, Hulk saved the Gamma Corps from

their deaths, but later stripped them of their powers.

Equipment: Prodigy designs all the equipment for the team.

Each team member has a small microchip installed in their heads, which allows them to communicate as a team through Prodigy's telepathy with worldwide range. It still requires vocal communication, however.

Transportation: None known.

Weapons: Prodigy designs and makes high-tech weapons for the team as well.

Through his trials growing up as well as in the military, Talbot has grown cold, but still holds a grudge against those who have slighted him. He has no



reservation at the use of violence in order to complete the mission at hand.

HISTORY

Brian Talbot felt his brother Glenn was a self-absorbed, abusive monster. and he hated him for it; but it was easier to blame Glenn's obsession with the Hulk for his behavior. General John Ryker approached Brian sometime after Glen was killed while pursuing the Hulk, reinforcing Brian's beliefs that Hulk was responsible for Glenn's Agreeing demise. to undergo experimental procedures in order to get revenge against Hulk, Brian was injected with Hulk blood and Leader (Samuel Sterns) DNA to keep potential uncontrollable rampages in check. Brian became Grey, field leader of Ryker's Gamma Corps, and was a model soldier.

ROLEPLAYING NOTES

Always a low-keyed villain as the Clown, he now enjoys the power he has as the Griffin. While he's now a government operative, he is still a violent thug that revels in brutality. However, he still can't help but crack jokes, continuing to be a clown.

HISTORY

Eliot Franklin was born in Orlando, Florida, the son of a man named Corky. When he began his criminal career, he joined the Ringmaster's Circus of Crime, working as a circus clown, comedian, juggler, and unicyclist. There first major crime spree involved the Ringmaster hypnotizing entire towns while Clown and the rest of the trope robbed every one of their wealth, they attempted this on Rick Jones but he summoned the Hulk through a mental link they shared. Upon his arrival, the Clown and others managed

to subdue the Hulk and chain him up until he broke free as the FBI arrived to arrest Clown and the circus.

When the Circus of Crime acted independently of the Ringmaster, the Clown often served as the leader. For a time he broke from the Circus, setting himself up as a professional hitman, and clashing with Deathlok when he tried to kill his former friend the Ringmaster (who had reinvented himself as a political candidate).

Later the Clown underwent Gamma mutation to become the Gamma Corps' Griffin.

ROLEPLAYING NOTES

Mess held the Hulk responsible for her son's death, and was driven for revenge. However, she has grown softer after finding out that it was the Abomination that killed her son.

HISTORY

Nichole Martin was involved in the sidelines of a Hulk/Abomination battle that cost her the loss of her arm, leg and eye after a garbage truck fell from

the sky and onto her car, and where her son Johnny burned to death. Blaming the Hulk for the incident, she accepted the grafting of cloned parts of the Abomination replacing the limbs she'd lost for a chance to gain revenge against the Hulk, and then joined the Gamma Corps created by Gen. Ryker with the code name of Mess. After fighting and nearly beating the Hulk in World War Hulk, Mess came to terms with the loss of her son after the Hulk apologized for her loss. This sends Mess into tears and gave her a sense of relief.

Later her teammate Prodigy revealed to her through video footage that it was not the Hulk, but Abomination that threw the truck that killed her son and caused the loss of her limbs

ROLEPLAYING NOTES

Gideon acts as the resident ears to the team members' concerns and fears.

HISTORY

Although appearing to look much older than his brother the Falcon, Sam claims he raised his brother and sister. Gideon Wilson became a minister (like his father), but when his son Jim died of AIDS, he blamed the Hulk and vowed revenge on him.

He underwent exposure to gamma radiation to gain Doc Samson-like powers but with opposite effects. He attempted to beat the Hulk, but during the fight, he realized that this wasn't what he wanted, acknowledging the Hulk's points that Jim had died of AIDS and admitting that he was only attacking the Hulk because he was ashamed at his own failures as a father.

Years later, Gideon Wilson was visited by his brother. Now apparently powerless, he had become a pastor in New York, where he ran AA meetings from a parish common room. He expressed his pride at his brother becoming Captain America.

GROUP HISTORY

After the success of the first Gamma Corps, Norman Osborn ordered General John Ryker to create a new Gamma Corps, composed of female "volunteers". These so-called volunteers were all mentally unstable ex-soldiers waiting on death row. The trio was taken to the Origins Corporation to be used in their gene therapy program. General Ryker then sent the team to capture the Lyra the new She-Hulk, so they can harvest her DNA

They the trio attacked and killed Lyra's fellow A.R.M.O.R. agents and took her personal computer, Boudicca, which drove her to hunt them down, first apparently killing Morass by drying out her Glob-like body.

The pair headed for a small nearby town, attempting to hold the people hostage in order to make Lyra surrender. In the battle Lyra badly hurt Aberration, causing her body to mutate into a tumorous mess, and then apparently killed her with a metal pipe through the head. Axon then threatened to electrocute the whole town unless Lyra surrendered.

Axon absorbed most of Lyra's bioelectric energy, absorbing her powers. Lyra then made Axon angry, causing the stolen powers to weaken. Axon was then apparently killed remotely by General Ryker's troops.


NOTE: Each of the Gamma Corps: Black members have a fail-safe installed in them, which can be remotely detonated inside of them, killing them.

Aberration is easily prone to insults and is very eager to take vengeance for any slight against her.

HISTORY

Private Rana Philips was an Abomination/human experiment, similar to the original Gamma Corps member Mess. Philips was a more slender female version of the original Abomination.

Private Philips was imprisoned as her commanding officer used her as a scapegoat as he tortured prisoners, leading her to kill him. Private Philips was sentenced to death, leaving her nothing to lose being altered by Ryker's experiment.

Her first mission with Gamma Corps: Black was to apprehend Lyra and Boudicca. After taking over a small desert town in California and being badly wounded by Lyra, her body began to mutate into a tumorous mass which Lyra then killed by shoving a massive pipe into her head. It is unknown if her regenerative abilities can heal her current wound, or how that would affect her.

Electric Body: Axon's body is now primarily made of electromagnetic power. This gives her the following power stunts:

Electrical Generation: She can fire bolts of Incredible electrical Energy up to 3 areas away.

Force Field: Axon can generate a bioelectric field, that gives her Incredible protection against physical and energy attacks. Flight: Axon has the ability to fly at Remarkable air speed (15 areas/round).

Bio-Vampirism: Axon loses one Health point per turn. She must feed on the electrical energy contained within the body of human beings. She regains a number of Health points equal to a victim's Endurance. To drain a victim, she must make a Fighting FEAT roll and be able to overcome an opponent's resistance to Electrical energy damage. She is able to drain up to 40 points per round. She also absorbs the knowledge of the victim, raising her Reason to a level one less than that of the smartest victim. She also absorbs the inherent (natural) abilities of her victims when she has drained them completed. However, she also absorbs their respective weaknesses as well.

Phasing: Remarkable ability to become intangible.

WEAKNESS:

Axon suffers from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder, causing her at times to believe she is back in Symkaria during her military duties, where she was the sole survivor of an ambush that killed the rest of her squad. When in combat, she must make a green Psyche FEAT. Failing the FEAT, means she believes she is back in Symkaria, and any civilians around her are potential insurgent forces.

ROLEPLAYING NOTES

Of the three Gamma Corps: Black members, Axon is the most vicious and cruel.

HISTORY

Erin Cicero was a military prisoner, but was given the option of negating her sentence by signing up for dangerous experiments by a group of Army scientists under John Ryker.

Staff Sergeant Erin Cicero signed up for the experiment because she was going to be put to death for the murder of 6 people, including her husband and 2 children. Before returning home she had seen her entire platoon killed during peace-keeping operations in Symkaria and shipped home. Suffering from post-traumatic stress, this led her to believe that her family was insurgent spies and killed them.

Her first mission with Gamma Corps: Black was to apprehend Lyra and Boudicca. After taking over a small desert town in California, she absorbed most of Lyra's bio-electricity but after Lyra made her angry, Axon found herself weakened, so returned those powers to Lyra. Before Lyra could kill her like she had with the rest of Gamma Corps: Black, General Ryker had her remotely terminated for being known by too many civilians. However, given her abilities and the origin of those powers, she may have survived somehow.

Plasticity: Morass is able to reshape her body to deflect damage or to create different weapon types, such as hammers, with Incredible ability.

WEAKNESSES:

Silent: Morass is unable to speak. Vulnerable to heat: As a creature made of radioactive mud, Morass is vulnerable to drying out. Any attack by flame or heat, she must make a Yellow Endurance FEAT, with her Endurance reduced by the intensity of the heat. She is also vulnerable to anything that would reduce her moisture content significantly (such as salt flats).

Little is known about Morass - she follows order with little disagreement.

HISTORY

Morass is an unnamed female soldier who is a Glob/human experiment. The soldier was given the abilities of the original Glob, and she appeared to look like a more slender, female version of the original.

Morass was arrested due to unknown reasons. Morass was sentenced to death, leaving her with nothing to lose by being altered by the Origins Corporation gene therapy program.

She was killed during Gamma Corps: Black's first mission by Lyra, who they had been sent to kill and obtain Boudicca. When Lyra split her body with a punch, she tried to reconstruct herself from the earth around her, which at the time was an alkali salt flat. This instantly dried her out and Lyra destroyed her body, apparently killing her. However, it is unknown if she were to be rehydrated, if that would revive her,

given her abilities.

Containment pod: In order to contain super-powered individuals, the dropship contains a pod that is made of Monstrous material strength, and is large enough to contain a Hulk-sized individual.

ROLEPLAYING NOTES

General Ryker is cold and calculating. He also has absolutely no reservations about doing whatever is needed to succeed – to him, the ends justify the means.

HISTORY

Next to nothing is known about General Ryker's past. Involved with just about every conspiracy in the government for the past several decades, he has developed mutated strains of polio to test on illegal immigrants, introduced toxins into cocaine to make its victims more susceptible to genetic alterations, and s

even rumored to have played a role in a presidential assassination. But nobody could ever Mace the blame for any of this on him because, on paper, he doesn't even officially exist.

General Ryker claims to have been with the Hulk since the gamma bomb explosion. However, it was only recently that he decided to make his presence known. Ryker had inadvertently horribly mutated his wile experimenting with gamma rays to try to cure her cancer. Thus he sought the aid of Dr. Bruce Banner. Tracking the Hulk's radiation via satellite, Ryker sent gamma-irradiated dogs after him. After that failed, he took a strong military force to Angela Lipscombe's home, surrounding both it and the Hulk. The Hulk escaped with both Dr. Lipscombe and a photograph of General Ryker ...but for reasons all his own, this is what Ryker had planned all along.

At this point, Ryker began decimating Bruce Banner's personal Ike piece by piece. He started by coercing General Ross to assist him, threatening to destroy the preserved body of Betty Ross. The General followed up by pitting another gammairradiated pawn of his, Flux, against the Hulk. As Ryker had anticipated, the Hulk triumphed, and Flux learned that Ryker had been responsible for his mutation and past misfortune.

General Ryker finally succeeded in capturing Banner by holding Flux, Doc Samson, Angela Lipscombe, and others as hostages, forcing Banner's cooperation. Ryker took them to the top secret government facility known as Area 51, where he hooked the Hulk up to a machine that held him captive by focusing all his energy bad, at him. With his machines, Ryker wreaked havoc on the Hulk's body and mind, but the Hulk escaped when General Ross had a change of heart and set him free.
